

# SLOW THE SPREAD OF COVID-19

## COVID-19 Testing is Available in Fairfax & surrounding jurisdictions

### 1 CHECK FOR SYMPTOMS

The most common symptoms of COVID-19 are fever of >100.4F cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.

If you have severe symptoms continue to step 2. If you have mild symptoms and are over 65 years old, pregnant, have a serious medical condition, like diabetes, or are in another high-risk category, continue to step 2.

**IF YOU HAVE MILD OR NO SYMPTOMS, YOU DON'T NEED TO BE TESTED.**

Most people who get COVID-19 recover on their own at home and do not need testing or treatment. Anyone with symptoms of respiratory illness should stay home & avoid contact with others; wear a face covering when around others; wash hands frequently; disinfect surfaces regularly and inform close contacts you are sick.

### 2 CALL FIRST

If you're having chest pain or trouble breathing, call 911. Otherwise, call your doctor, if you have one.

If you don't have a doctor or insurance, call one of the clinics listed in this document.

The doctor or clinic will make an appointment for you to be screened in person or online. To protect others, do not visit your doctor or clinic without calling ahead first.

### 3 GET SCREENED

If you are screened online and need a test, the doctor or clinic will schedule an appointment for you or refer you to a testing site.

If you are screened in person, and the doctor determines you need a test, the doctor or clinic will collect a test sample if they are equipped as a testing site, or they will refer you to a testing site.

If you are screened in person, and the doctor determines you don't need a test, follow the guidance to care for yourself at [fairfaxcounty.gov/health/novel-coronavirus/symptoms](https://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/health/novel-coronavirus/symptoms)

All testing sites require pre-screening, a doctor's order and most require appointments. Due to limited testing resources, the CDC recommends prioritized testing for the following: hospitalized patients; symptomatic healthcare facility workers; symptomatic residents of long-term care facilities or other congregate living settings; persons with symptoms of COVID-19; or persons without symptoms prioritized by their clinicians for public health monitoring & surveillance.

### 4 GIVE A SAMPLE

A test sample will be collected by a health care worker wearing personal protective equipment (PPE) like goggles, masks or respirators, gowns and gloves.

The sample will be collected by swabbing your nose or mouth, and the swab will be sealed and sent to a laboratory for testing.

### 5 RECEIVE RESULTS

You will be notified when the results are available.

While waiting for results, it's important that you stay home and stay away from others and wear a cloth face covering.

If you have COVID-19, you will receive further guidance to help protect yourself and others and to identify your close contacts.
