Rev. Dr. Jerry L. Bryant, Pastor



Rev. Dr. Jerry L. Bryant, Jr. accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior at the age of 12 at New Zion Baptist Church in Magnolia, Mississippi. Under the tutelage of Pastor Victor G. Williams of First Baptist Church of Maplewood, Missouri, Pastor Bryant accepted his call into the ministry and was licensed to preach in 1986. He was ordained in 1992 by Pastor Richard Rollins at the First Missionary Baptist Church of Ballwin, Missouri after being catechized by several area pastors. Pastor Bryant was called to be the 7th Pastor of the Chantilly Baptist Church, Chantilly, VA, founded in 1880, and was installed on May 7, 2000. Under his pastorate, a number of new ministries have been formed or revitalized, and a new \$2.1 million building was built in 2003, and the mortgage was burned in 2011.


Pastor Bryant has served as an Associate Minister at First Baptist Church of Maplewood and as Associate Pastor/Teacher of First Missionary Baptist Church of Ballwin. Pastor Leroy O. Payton named him First Assistant to the Pastor at Chantilly Baptist Church in 1997, where he joined in September 1996, four months after relocating to Northern Virginia. Pastor Bryant's ministerial experiences include teaching Sunday school (teens and adults), served on the Board of Christian Education (as a member and chairman), Children's Church Pastor/Teacher, a Bible Study teacher/coordinator and has been a member of several choirs. He has completed and taught the National Evangelism Movement, Inc. (NEM) training curriculum of the Bethany Christian Bible College of West Los Angeles, CA. since 1986, and is currently the lead facilitator of the Pastor's Plenary class at the annual National Evangelism Workshop since 2009. He also moderates the graduation exercises for the annual National Evangelism Workshop. In December 2008, he graduated from the Pastoral Excellence Program, Lott Carey Foreign Missions, after engaging in three annual foreign mission immersions to Guyana, South Africa, and Jamaica, and remains engaged in foreign missions. He is active and serves as the Chair of the Commission on Evangelism and President of Region 4 of the Northern Virginia Association.

Pastor Bryant was born in Magnolia, Mississippi. He holds a B.S. Degree in Natural Science from Mississippi Valley State University with honors in 1971 and a Ph.D. in Microbiology/Molecular Biology from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) (1978), the first earned by an African American male in the MIT biology department. He worked in industry at Monsanto and Lee Scientific, and in academe as a research scientist and served on the graduate faculty of the University of Missouri-St. Louis. He served at the United Negro College Fund, Inc. as the National Director of Science Education Initiatives, where he directed the highly prestigious

UNCF/Merck Science Initiative, which supported the development and training of African Americans in the biomedical research and engineering fields. He served on the MIT Biology Department Visiting Committee of the MIT Corporation, the Advisory Committee of the Burroughs Wellcome Fund Postdoctoral Enrichment Program (PDEP), and various other programs that support the development of minority biomedical researcher scientists.

He is married to his college sweetheart, Earnestine Howard Bryant. They have three children, two daughters, Keisha, and Marlynn (deceased), a son, Keir Jason, two granddaughters and two grandsons.

He continues to be prayerful as he does what the Lord has called him to do which is to preach and teach the gospel at Chantilly Baptist Church and to a lost and dying world. His favorite scripture is: Matthew 28:19-20. "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you, and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen."



Dr. Keith Savage, Senior Servant Biographical Sketch



Dr. Keith Savage has been the Senior Servant of First Baptist Church of Manassas, VA (FBC) since August 2002. FBC is an active, growing, mission-minded, servant Christian community of believers who seek to 'Move the Kingdom Forward through Faith' for Christ in worship, discipleship, fellowship, evangelism, and overall ministry. "Bring them in, build them up, teach them how, and send them out."

Our Kingdom Mandate at FBC is to continually become "Discipled People, Serving People, Into a Love Relationship with Jesus Christ." We are empowered and commissioned to "Be FBC Strong!"

Dr. Savage volunteers his time and talents locally, nationally, and worldwide through various ecumenical and social justice organizations. He has been a featured preacher, teacher, and speaker locally and internationally. He serves as a volunteer chaplain with the Manassas City police department and Northern Virginia hospitals.

Dr. Savage is Co-chair of Virginians Organized for Interfaith Community Engagement (www.voice-iaf.org) and serves on the General Board of the Baptist General Convention of Virginia. He also serves on the Board of Directors for the Metro IAF Community Restoration Fund, LLC (Fund), The Fund makes investments in real estate to rebuild neighborhoods and finance affordable homeownership and rental housing in target areas around the United States for development, preservation, and revitalization.

Dr. Savage was a driving force in bringing community/law enforcement/faith leaders together during the 2020 protests in Prince William County, Manassas City, and Manassas Park. Together, they forged an effective partnership in reform efforts and conversation. He is among of team of Northern Virginia clergy and lay leaders pushing for greater affordable housing and mental health access and facilities throughout the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Dr. Savage continues to travel the world as an ambassador for Christ on missionary journeys. He is a licensed and ordained Baptist Minister. He has affiliations with the American Baptist Churches USA, Lott Carey Mission Convention, Baptist General Convention of Virginia, and the Northern Virginia Baptist Association. He is an author who has contributed chapters and articles to various published Christian books and journals.

Dr. Keith Savage is married to the love of his life Bonita, and they are the proud parents of two adult children (Keith II and Kayla), a daughter-in-law Jeanice Reed-Savage, and grandsons Keith III and Judah.

Dr. Savage earned his undergraduate degree from Washington University in St. Louis, MO (1987), his Master of Divinity degree (cum laude) from the Samuel DeWitt Proctor of School of Theology, Virginia Union Univ. in Richmond, VA (1998), and his Doctor of Ministry degree from United Theological Seminary, Dayton, OH (2013).

Dr. Savage has mentored and taught at Seminaries in Ohio and Virginia. He takes to heart the wisdom that says, "Let them know who you are by the words you speak and the actions you take."

Rev. Dr. Eugene Johnson

Born in New Orleans and raised in Oakville, Louisiana, Rev. Dr. Eugene Johnson was nurtured in a devout Baptist home where his father pastored and his mother worked tirelessly for the causes of Christ. He currently resides in Manvel, Texas.



Dr. Johnson faithfully served as Pastor of Mount Olive Baptist Church in Centreville, Virginia for nearly 31 years, retiring in 2023 after a total of 37 years in pastoral ministry. Under his leadership, Mount Olive grew from a small suburban church into one of Northern Virginia's most progressive congregations—expanding its ministries, outreach, and membership while remaining a spiritual cornerstone in the DMV region. His ministry emphasized Christian discipleship, community service, and programs that drew men and youth to Christ.

An architect by profession and a pastor by calling, Dr. Johnson combined both disciplines to lead Mount Olive in constructing a new multi-million-dollar, state-of-the-art facility—one he personally designed. His architectural vision earned national recognition for its sa-

cred artistry and structural excellence.

A proud graduate of Southern University (B.Arch., 1970) and Howard University School of Divinity (M.Div., 1989), he was awarded an Honorary Doctor of Divinity by Richmond Virginia Seminary in 2006. Before entering full-time ministry, Dr. Johnson served as Principal Resident Architect with the U.S. Department of Transportation, where he broke racial barriers and helped preserve the historic Selma-to-Montgomery Voting Rights March route as an All-American Road.

He has held major leadership roles in the Northern Virginia Baptist Association as Moderator, and the Lott Carey Baptist Foreign Mission Convention, leading mission trips across Africa and extending Mount Olive's Christian witness to six continents. His honors include the Howard University Pillar of Faith Award, Radio One PRAISE 104.1 Top Pastor Recognition, and the 2023 Centreville Day Lifetime Leadership Award.

Now a member of New Faith Church in Houston, Dr. Johnson continues mentoring ministers and assisting in ministry development. Above all, he cherishes his family: his wife June L. Lambert Johnson, their sons Brian and Kevin, and grandchildren Marley and Jadin.




sionate teacher, he has taught Bible Study, Sunday School, and Ministers-in-Training classes, and has facilitated national Christian leadership and evangelism conferences.


Dear Reverend Doctor Bryant,
